## **Trippin' Day Camp Indianapolis, IN (July 14-18, 2008)**

### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

To help insure that participants have a good, safe time, the following Code of Conduct will be in effect during the Trippin' day camp.

1. Participants are expected to partake in assigned activities and wear their name tags during all program activities.
2. Dress during the camp is casual. Jeans, T-shirts, etc., are fine. Clothing with offensive or obscene words, pictures, symbols, etc. is not acceptable. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all sessions and meals. No halter tops, tank tops or sleeveless shirts are allowed. Shorts length must be appropriate (when a person is standing straight with arms hanging to side, shorts must meet or pass their fingertips). Pants must not sag, or a belt will be provided.
3. Language and conduct should reflect the values we proclaim as Catholics.
4. Participants are to remain with their group at all times during the mission unless accompanied by adult chaperones.
5. Socializing will take place only in the designated common areas. As a participant, you are allowed only in the area you have been assigned.
6. Smoking and the use of tobacco products is not allowed by any participants during the camp. Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the camp.
7. The possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons will not be tolerated. Breaking this rule will mean immediate dismissal from the camp. (Parents will be called, regardless of the hour.)
8. The possession and use of cell phones/pagers is prohibited (see below)
9. No food and/or drinks are allowed outside of designated snack breaks and lunchtime.



## **What Do I Bring for the Trippin' Day Camp?**

- ✓ Pack a sack lunch (that is labeled with your last name) every day.
- ✓ Towel and appropriate bathing suit for swimming day. (Girls must wear a one piece bathing suit or a tankini. They must wear t-shirts if they are wearing bikinis.)
- ✓ Water bottle (that is labeled with your last name) every day.
- ✓ In-expensive camera.
- ✓ Bible and rosary.
- ✓ Comfortable old clothes (that might get very dirty tattered or torn)  
Shorts must be fingertip length when one stands with arms hanging at their sides. Pants must not sag. A belt will be provided if they do. No halter tops, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts are allowed.
- ✓ Athletic apparel for free time (athletic shoes, shorts etc.)
- ✓ Work gloves (every day) that are labeled with your last name.
- ✓ Work shoes, boots, or old sneakers (every day). Absolutely no open-toed shoes or sandals unless we are at the pool.

## **What *not* to bring**

- ✓ Cell Phones-group leaders will have phones and contact information  
Group leader cell phones will be distributed to all parents or guardians

  - ✓ Video Games
  - ✓ I-Pod or other MP3 player
  - ✓ DVD

I hereby give permission to the medical staff to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injection, anesthesia, or surgery for my child.
