Sponsors are a very important part of our Confirmation program. We request that sponsors please attend the large group meetings. If you are using a sponsor who lives out of town a parent may fill in for the sponsor. Please give careful thought to choosing your sponsor.

Role of Sponsor

- a. a friend who knows the candidate and can witness to the maturing faith of the candidate
- b. a mature guide, confidant and listener
- c. ideally one would use their godparent
- d. must be 16 and confirmed
- e. cannot be a parent of one being Confirmed
- f. someone who is going to continue the relationship after Confirmation

Sponsors Are Spiritual Role Models

We all have people we admire from childhood heroes to adult role models. We see certain qualities or accomplishments in others and in some way strive to imitate them. It might be the ability of a ballplayer or the skill of a doctor, or the knowledge and ease of a teacher, or the love and devotion of our parents. We see in others qualities and talents that make them great.

In the community of faith, we have role models. The most common are the saints - ordinary people who lived faith in extraordinary ways. There are priests and parishioners whose virtue and faith inspire others to greatness. Finally, there are sacramental sponsors in baptism and confirmation. They show us by word and example how to live and practice the faith we profess.

Choosing a sponsor is serious business. Sponsors are spiritual role models - future saint makers! We need to pick those who really believe, not simply because they are friends or relatives, but because they can show us or our children the way of Jesus. Good sponsors have the virtues and qualities that imitate the greatest of role models, Jesus himself. Who better to admire, to serve or to love?

Confirmation Name

A Confirmation name will be required if a candidate does not have a saint's name in their Baptismal name. If they do, it is up to the candidate if he/she would like to take another name.

1. *Paragraphs:* The candidate should turn in two paragraphs about his/her chosen saint. One paragraph should be an *unplagiarized* brief history or biography of the saint. The second paragraph should be why he/she has chosen that particular saint.

2. *How do I choose a saint?* There are over 10,000 saints! It might be difficult to choose from such a vast number.

One way to choose is to look up a patron saint. Patron saints are special protectors or guardians over different areas of life. I could look up a specific topic that I am interested in. Then I could see who the patron saint is for that topic.

- I am interested in missions. I like to go on mission trips and do missionary work. The patron saint of missions is Francis Xavier.

- I am a musician. I love playing piano, guitar, drums, etc. The patron saint of musicians is Gregory the Great.

Another way to choose a saint is to do so based on a story in the Bible or Catholic history.

- Saint Patrick was kidnapped and taken to Ireland. He ended up converting most of the country to Catholicism. I admire him for that. Therefore I will choose Patrick as my Confirmation name.
- Saint Peter denied Jesus three times. Yet, he was the rock upon which the church was built. I connect with Peter because he was not perfect, but God believed in him. Therefore I will choose Peter as my Confirmation name.
- Saint Paul wrote most of the New Testament. He walked all over Asia and told people about Jesus. Therefore I will choose Paul as my Confirmation name.

You want to choose a saint as a spiritual role model. You want to choose a saint that you admire and want to emulate.

Service Requirements:

Students are required to do 20 hours of service.

- 10 hours: must be completed *in the parish*. Any service you sign up for through the parish is considered in the parish.
- 6 hours: must be completed *outside the parish*. A service you are not expected to do as a chore or do not get paid for counts.
- 4 hours: must be completed by participating in *parish life*. Two of the four hours will be completed when the candidate participates in the two youth masses coordinated by his/her small group. Being a cantor, musician, usher, or server for liturgy are good examples. The candidate must then attend one high school youth council meeting.
- 1 hour: must be completed by attending a complete **parish meeting**. Some examples are: parish council, youth council, faith formation, school commission, liturgy committee, family life committee, building and grounds, and stewardship. If you choose to attend youth council for this requirement, you will be attending twice since the first time counted for parish life.
- Confirmation service hours cannot count for school or any other organization.
- The first ten hours must be completed by January 9th, 2011. Complete service hour requirements are due by Sunday, March 20th, 2011

*** If you question whether or not the hours you want to do will be accepted as service hours, or if you want to know if they will fulfill the above requirements, please seek pre-approval by your small group leader or youth minister.*
